- Electrical studies corroborating MRI findings by demonstrating chronic S1 radiculopathy for the right lower extremity

Residuals

- Constant daily low back pain
- Intermittent daily radiating right leg pain, numbness and tingling extending to the right foot and toes
- Prolonged standing and/or walking causes pain
- Routine daily activities causes pain (e.g., cleaning, cooking, bending, lifting)
- Physical activity level restricted
- Pain interferes with sleeping
- Can no longer enjoy recreational activities such as running and skiing
- Pain restricts and interferes with child care duties and playing with children
