FACTS/CONTENTIONS

According to plaintiff: On March 19, 2000, plaintiff, a 36-year-old homemaker, was walking in a church parking lot, when she was struck by a vehicle driven by defendant.

Defendant admitted liability but disputed the need for plaintiff's claimed future surgery.

CLAIMED INJURIES

According to plaintiff: Fractured right fibula head; non-displaced lateral tibial plateau fracture, requiring open reduction and internal fixation and future surgery to remove hardware.

CLAIMED DAMAGES

According to plaintiff: \$25,350 past medical; \$50,000 future medical.

SETTLEMENT DISCUSSIONS

According to plaintiff: Demand: \$100,000 (policy limits) from registered owner's insurer, which was tendered within 30 days of the demand; plaintiff then demanded an additional \$100,000 (policy limits) from the driver's insurer, which was tendered within 30 days of the demand.
