FACTS/CONTENTIONS

According to plaintiff: On January 14, 2011. Plaintiff Robert Waldren, a 46-year-old student services coordinator, was riding his bicycle southbound on Bake Parkway in the bicycle lane in Lake Forest at the intersection with Commerce Center Drive, when defendant James Ray Carlyle, who was driving a 2006 Chevrolet 1500 truck southbound on Bake Parkway, suddenly attempted to make a right turn onto Commercecentre Drive from the #1 lane, cutting plaintiff off and causing plaintiff to hit defendant's vehicle.

Plaintiff alleged that defendant driver was negligent in the operation of his vehicle and that all of plaintiff's claimed injuries were a direct result of said negligence. Defendant accepted liability.

CLAIMED INJURIES

According to plaintiff: Five rib fractures; left clavicle fracture; closed reduction; open reduction internal fixation surgery several weeks later.

CLAIMED DAMAGES

According to plaintiff: \$29,506 medical.

SETTLEMENT DISCUSSIONS

According to plaintiff: Demand: \$100,000 policy limit accepted in settlement of claim.
